



Driver FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

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Is this a job or an offer for employment?

This is NOT an offer of employment. You will not be working for Cars To Florida. This is just a great way to travel for very little expense.

How do I qualify to be a driver?

To drive for our clients you must:

- *Have a clean driver license and criminal abstract*
- *Provide proof of Driver abstract (obtained through your Provincial Ministry eg Service Ontario kiosk)*
- *Provide a \$500 deposit on credit card*
- *Be highly dependable, friendly and communicative*

Will I be paid?

We make you an offer depending on mileage, car type etc which is an expense reimbursement. It is not intended to earn you a profit.

What about fuel en route, accommodations, and airfare home?

All expenses are yours and will usually be covered from the offer we make you. This means that fuel, tolls, accommodations and airfare home are all your responsibility. The fee you are paid is designed to assist with these expenses. Many drivers will at least break even. We have a preferred rate at a motel approximately half way from Toronto to Florida when the Cars To Florida Driver Contract is presented at the check in desk. Our current rate is a flat \$33.99 USD for single or double occupancy. You can find great deals on airfare through sources such as www.expedia.ca, www.travelocity.ca, and many others. If Buffalo is an option for you, airfares between Florida and Buffalo can often be very good.

What should I know about the border crossing?

Due to recent Customs changes, this has become a much more formalized procedure. We are a registered carrier and will provide you the necessary paperwork (including a new e-manifest)

How much time will I have to deliver the vehicle?

Most drivers complete approximately 700 miles per day which means Toronto, Ottawa and Montreal to Florida is usually a 2 day trip. Our contract will allow you 3 days on these routes (inclement weather, choosing more breaks or shorter days). Similarly, Halifax to Florida is a 3 day trip and the contract will allow for 4 days.

Can I get a vehicle to drive both ways?

As you can imagine, our Clients generally travel south in the fall, winter and return north in the spring. As a result, our deliveries tend to be one way each season. For this reason, the likelihood of getting a car to drive both ways is very low.

Why do you require a deposit?

This is a basic security step (as per a car rental agreement) to ensure your commitment to the delivery and the highest quality result to our Clients.

How much is the deposit?

\$500 CAD on a major credit card.

When do I get my deposit back?

Your deposit will be refunded upon good delivery of the vehicle per our Driver Contract.

How do I get paid?

You can opt to have your credit card credited with your fee or we can email money transfer (if you use internet banking) or simply mail you a cheque.

How does insurance work?

The vehicle is insured for the drive.

What if I am involved in an accident?

You are insured. However, your deposit will cover the insurance deductible.

How many occupants can I bring in the vehicle?

Our clients will load the trunk with their personal belongings and will often spill over with lighter items into the back seat. As the driver, we only guarantee the front 2 seats to you. i.e. yourself and one other occupant is the max you will be able to take on the trip.

How do I obtain my Drivers Abstract?

Visit your Provincial Ministry or Ministry website. Ontario has a Service Ontario kiosk which will provide an abstract very easily and quickly.

I am interested. How do I get involved as a driver?
